

Mr. Silvers brings you into his character's world and keeps you there using a mixture of witty banter, action, and a deeply developed plot. This is the third book in this series and if you haven't read the first two, I highly recommend them. After some thought, the best description I can come up with is this: All of these characters seem like people I'd like to share a beer with. Those are the types of characters you want to spend time with, lose yourself in a book with, and enjoy the passing of time with WITHOUT noticing the passing of time. Carry on Mr. Silvers, bring on Vol. 4.

While visiting Achillesâ <sup>™</sup> bar, Nate Temple hears that vampires have been snatching girls and taking them down into the sewers, never to be heard from again. Achillesâ <sup>™</sup> own bartender has suspiciously gone missing, so Nate decides to do him a favor to make things right between them. So he, his werewolf friend Gunnar, and girlfriend Indie head for the sewers.Under vicious attack by

the vampires â " he of course had found a nest of them and not just the one vampire he had intended â " he and his friends were not giving a stellar performance defending themselves. But when one of the vampires heard his name mentioned, they hurriedly backed off rather than face â œThe Makerâ •. He still wasnâ ™t fully aware exactly how to harness these Maker powers, but that would never stop him or even give him pause.He finds out that the Brothers Grimm have responded to a contract out on him and anyone who is close to him. They want their two dangerous books back which he had never destroyed as he probably should have. But regardless, they want him dead; and they never fail. And now the Grimms are loose in the world again and on a rampage. It doesnâ ™t look like Nate and his friends are going to be able to defeat them this time around unless something drastically changes. And if they lose this battle, the rest of the Grimms will return to the world to destroy all things magical!Nate is a zany character that you quickly come to enjoy. Heâ ™s really funny, and the tongue-in-cheek humor is amazing. Heâ ™s in a tough spot, but he has so much determination and will readily give his life for his friends. You really need to read the novella Fairy Tale before this book. Reading Obsidian Son and Blood Debts will help flesh out and add depth to the character interactions and history, but Fairy Tales is a MUST.I was eagerly awaiting the third installment of the Nate Temple series and, for the most part, was not disappointed. The book started in a bit of a ramble. It took a little while for the story to find its stride, but when it did, it was a fun ride! The Antagonist was cunning and brutal, twisting the story in unexpected ways. I agree with another reviewer who was confused at the fate of the bad guy because it was inconsistent with his persona up to that point. That being said, I loved that the story made me laugh, cry, throw my Kindle in frustration and ultimately nod my head as everything came together. In the tradition of true fairy tales, in this story people die, lives are ruined and the "good guy" is not infallible. Thankfully. There are enough loose ends to easily start another Nate Temple book (YAY!), but not so much as to be a cliffhanger.
