

I thought long and hard before getting copies of this book to give to our church's board (almost went with Alice Mann's The In-Between Church: Navigating Size Transitions in Congregations. Mann's book is shorter, much more succinct and better edited, but Latham's book is for UUs and has more details so eventually we went with this book. The title comes from an obscure road in Bermuda named for a church abandoned when the congregation failed to make the transition (apparently the pastoral to program transition). The book rambles, repeats itself, has no index (a pet peeve), and the author doesn't seem to come up for air (thesis sentience, argumentation, concluding sentence, PAUSE). I frequently find myself rereading paragraphs because I have completely blanked out on what the heck he is saying. Stylistically, I am not a big fan. I am reminded of the line in "A River Runs Through It" where Maclean's father keeps telling him to "write it again, half as long." I wish Latham had had this training. What keeps you reading and eventually sold this to the board is that Robert Latham really knows his stuff. He offers far more particulars than Mann and spends more

time reviewing other work than Mann. He offers more particulars than Mann for churches of any religion. But he is a UU and writes from a UU perspective about what is uniquely wrong with most UU churches (loss of connection to mission, Joys and Concerns, etc.). At times his assessments are bleak and his description of the loss of community in transition to a pastoral church may give the board pause.
