Could it work at all? If you want the answers, go get the book, it is definitely awesome. One of Anastasia Vitsky's strengths is character creation, and I love Alena and Raven just for who they are, how they have their own lives and struggles, what they do, and how their thoughts and actions make them so believable and very much like you and me. Seriously, Alena is lovely and touching just for being who she is, but at the same time I facepalmed because of some of her actions and wanted to

bring her back to her senses. The same applies to Raven. She is considerate and nevertheless almost blows it right at the beginning due to her fears. But this makes her humane and believable. The two of them are so different, but at the same time they complement each other so nicely. They are a lot of fun to read about. Colourful and slightly chaotic meets structured, demure and classy. Both women are looking for the same thing: someone to love. Since this starts out as a sort of business transaction, these two lovely women have to find out whether this could be the foundation for a lasting relationship. Raven's Girl was an absolute page-turner for me. I enjoyed the articulate and lively style of writing, how Alena and Raven got to know each other, the way they connected and how there was so much more than just spanking and the business arrangement essential for the story. At the core of it was how two women connect, long for a relationship, are very insecure about it, because this did not start as a love story in the first place.
