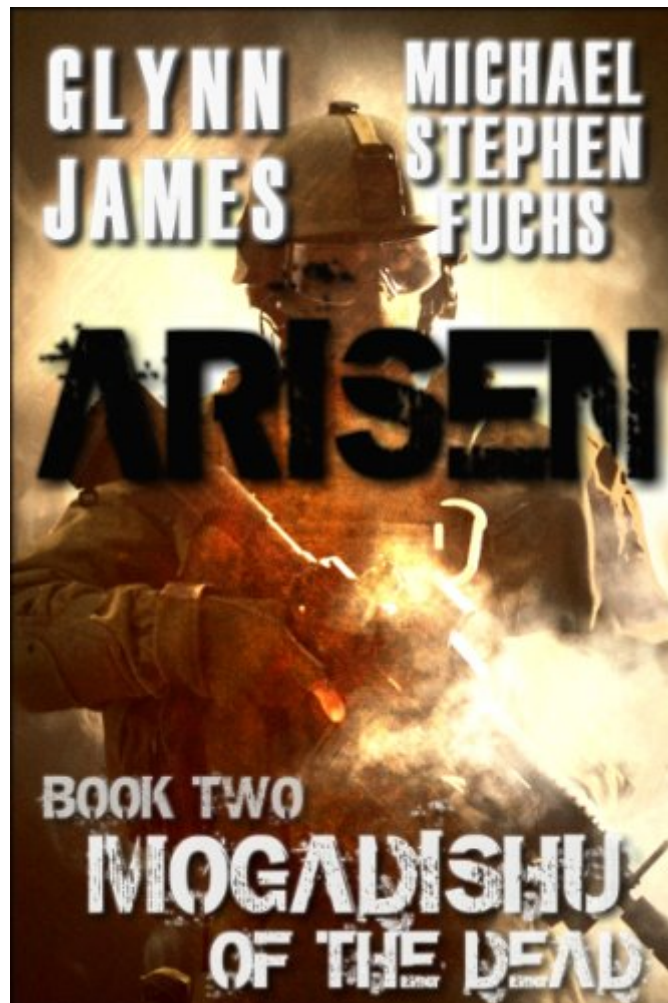

This second installment of the Arisen trilogy was all action, all the time after the briefest of stage setting. I love Ali (I wonder if any of others from D-Boys might show up?) and reading about the insertion into Chicago sure got my heart racing. This book has so much going on I wonder if the authors will be able to wrap it up in just one more volume, which is a not-so-subtle bump for more than three books. The real world of special operations in a smash up with zombie apocalypse is one winner here!

I'm going to say it, this is hands down my favorite zombie series (possibly the best mashup of military and zombies ever) I'm on book 10 and am still very much enthralled. If you're thinking of getting this be prepared for the heroin-like addiction. PS get the audio books. RC Bray is PERFECT.
