

I've always kinda looked down my nose at them ("booklike objects for tourists" -- I know, hopeless snobbery), but the wonderful cover photo caught my eye at the libe TOD....LANDFORMS is definitely worth a look for redrock rats & aspiring landscape photographers (in addition to the intended impulse-purchasers). Ladd's photos are truly stunning, and beautifully reproduced. The text is a decent Plateau geology-primer, though it's old-hat for me, and I must confess I just skimmed it. But the photos are wonderful.
